**"Nothing Through Strife Or
Vain Glory"**

In his letter to the saints at Philippi, Paul reminded them of the importance of possessing the proper attitude regarding spiritual matters. "Let nothing be done through strife or vainglory; but in lowliness of mind let each esteem other better than themselves. Look not every man on his own things, but every man also on the things of others. Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus:" (Philippians 2:3-5). I have made the statement that the word "attitude" was not found in the Bible. I was referring to the King James Version of the Bible, and I believe that it is not to be found in this version. However, we are to be careful when making such a statement when so many different versions and translations now exist. Rather than the word "mind", the New American Standard Version uses the word "attitude" in Philippians 2:5. Regardless of whether mind or attitude, the meaning is that we are to have the disposition or mental position which Jesus possessed if we hope to be like Him. It is good to take a check or examination at times. "Examine yourselves, whether ye be in the faith; prove your own selves. Know ye not your own selves, how that Jesus Christ is in you, except ye be reprobates?" (II Corinthians 13:5. **B. Thompson**
