ARE YOU READY FOR THE RAPTURE?

The word rapture is contained in some of the songs we sing. (*where it seems to mean extreme joy, e.g. "the rapturous chorus"*) and it is on the tongue of many people. Have you ever wondered where religious people got the word. I've looked it up in the Bible and it is not there.. To do additional research, I went to the commentary, the Expositors Bible Commentary, that I have on my computer hard drive. There I learned that in 1 Thessalonians 4:17, ("Then we who are alive and remain will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air, and so we shall always be with the Lord") the word translated "caught up" was translated in the Latin versions by the word "rapture." This is the source of this word in English, "rapture". So the word merely means that we will be caught up, snatched up to heaven to be with the Lord. There is nothing, then, too mysterious about the word, nor what Paul originally meant by what he wrote. The mystery is to explain how this word has turned into a multi-million dollar industry of books and movies that has all our neighbors so excited (And I am glad they are excited, because they might pay attention to the gospel of Jesus). But they don't seem to know what this catching up is. We need to get excited, too. We need to be excited because the Lord is coming again. We don't know when, but we know that he is coming. The fact is that he wants us to put our complete trust in him now, today, by our obedient faith so that we will be ready to welcome him when he does come. It is a fact that one day the saved of God will be caught up to be with the Lord. Will you be in that number? That is only a question that you can answer.
