WHY SHOULD I BE BAPTIZED?

Many people who believe in Christ and are sorry for their sins, put off being baptized, even though they know it is a command of the Lord. In the book of Acts, which contains many examples of conversion, people were baptized immediately, as soon as they believed in Jesus. They did this because they knew that baptism is for the forgiveness of sins (Acts 2:38) and to become a member of the body of Christ: "For by one Spirit we were all baptized into one body" (1 Corinthians 12:13). If you believe that Jesus is the Son of God and if you want to dedicate your life to God and be saved, "Why are you waiting?" "Arise and be baptized!" The word "baptize" is a transliteration of the Greek word "BAPTIZO" which means to immerse or dip. Bible baptism is an immersion in water. Churches that sprinkle or pour a little water on people are not following the Bible. What they do is not baptism, it is not immersion. In reality they do not baptize people at all. Someone who has only received "sprinkling" or "pouring" has not obeyed the command to be "baptized". The substance, water, has no magic power to wash away sins. In the act of baptism however is where we reach the blood of Jesus. Rom. 6. Baptism is not a meritorious work, but a gift of God that we receive, a "washing of regeneration" that cleanses us and saves us by the blood of Christ: "And now why are you waiting? Arise and be baptized, and wash away your sins, calling on the name of the Lord!" Amen DAN
