"Emmanuel" means "God with us." Based on the promise of Hebrews 13:5, "I will never leave thee nor forsake thee," we can say, "God is with us." The language of Matthew 1:21, which quotes from Isaiah 7:14 in the Old Testament, has a much stronger meaning. The language means that "this child born to Mary is God."
