Doubts and fears arise early in the morning, and late at night.

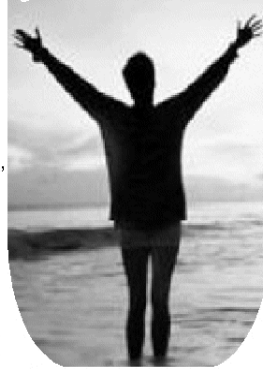
Start each day by taking Jesus and His love with you. Bring each day to a close by remembering His faithful promise, **"I Am With You Always!"**
