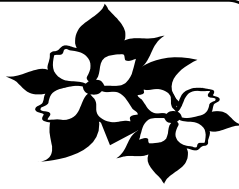
IN OUR PRAYERS

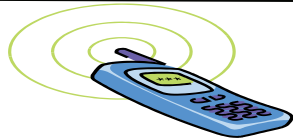


FROM DAN'S DESK..
