There are deodorant companies that promise to set us free from the worry of underarm wetness and odor; a certain toothpaste declares we can be set free from dull teeth. Then we are promised freedom from pain by Tylenol, Excedrin, Bayer, and others. Other products play on our desperation for freedom by telling us we can be free from "ringaround-the-collar," and Lysol sets us free from germs. What we should want most is freedom from sin. Paul said, "For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus made me free from the law of sin and of death" (Romans 8:2). "Then said Jesus to those Jews which believed on him, If ye continue in my word, then are ye my disciples indeed; And ve shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free" (John 8:31-32). This most important freedom can only be found in our obedience to Christ. "Though he were a Son, yet learned he obedience by the things which he suffered; And being made perfect, he became the author of eternal salvation unto all them that obey him" (Hebrews 5:8-9). "All Jesus said was to love each other...."????

I read the above statement in a newspaper column recently. The writer told about his children loving their mother, not out of rules and regulations, but out of her love for them. Then he compared this with Christ. He said, "Since Jesus himself didn't issue any commandments— other than the ancient words, 'Love God, love your neighbor' -- finding the rules has meant probing desperate sources such as Leviticus and Paul's epistles, and then putting those words into Jesus' mouth." For one to write such foolishness is almost unbelievable. Why would one ignore the many "rules" Jesus presented in the gospels and tag anyone who knows they are there as "legalists"? He quotes: "If you love me, keep my commandments," but simply dismisses that as the passage legalists have a field day with. When will shallow thinkers ever get it that rules are great! Loving people give rules for the well-being of others all the time. Parents give children rules (laws) constantly because they love them. Love and law are not mutually exclusive. Every rule the Lord gave us is good for us in the spiritual, moral, emotional, and even physical realm. (For instance, the prohibition against worry can help us emotionally and even physically.) Actually reading the Scripture would save a lot of people from making untrue declarations.
