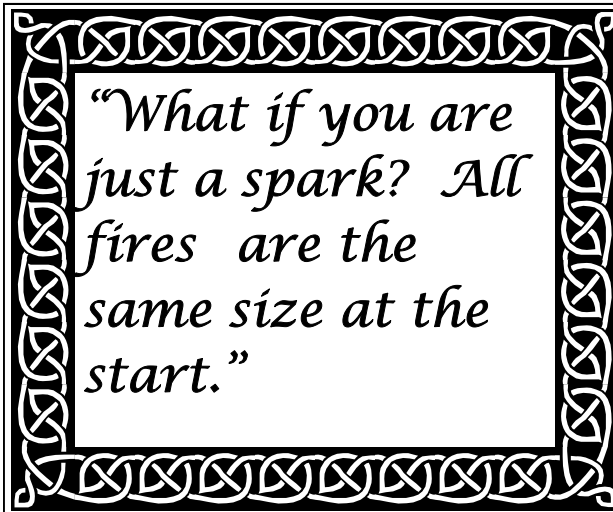


Worry doesn't eliminate tomorrow from its griefs, but it does empty today of its joy!

3. Wake up in the morning in a happy frame of mind. This would help my attitude and the family's so much more.
4. That sometimes I need time to be by myself just to window shop or walk. If he could stay with kids while I do this it would help me so much.
5. I need Christian fellowship and therefore want to invite them into my home. I wish he understood this need of mine.
6. I would like him to help me discipline the children. I don't want to be the "bad guy" anymore than he does. We need to do this together so that the children will mind and respect us.
7. I wish he would believe that, for me, crying at times is an almost uncontrollable thing and is not done on purpose to manipulate him or make him feel guilty. In fact, I usually feel better later.
8. To be more courteous and treat me like a woman by opening doors and speaking kindly of me in public, not contradicting my every sentence and deriding me before my friends.
9. That a woman needs to be reminded by her husband that he still loves her very much. Even after becoming a wife and mother she wants to be told over and over "I LOVE YOU."
10. That I want him to be my support during emotional times and during problems in my life. That he will just be there to hold me and say he understands. Women sometimes need a shoulder to cry on.
11. That a woman needs to be secure by his taking the leadership role.

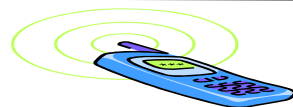
Monday Night For The Master
