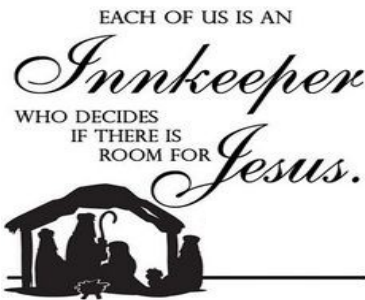

THE SILENCE OF THE SCRIPTURES

The reason silence can forbid when it cannot authorize is that God has said all that He intends to say on a matter. Since God said all He intended to say, to say more than He has said is presumptuous. His hushed silence authorizes nothing and forbids anything more. Our challenge is to never add to His words or take away from them. Some examples follow.

Noah was an example of such obedience. When Noah built the ark, God not only commanded Noah to build it; but He also said, "And this is how you shall make it" (Gen. 6:15). Noah did what God instructed him to do. "Thus Noah did; according to all that God had commanded him, so he did" (Gen. 6:22; 7:5). It was not Noah's purpose to vary from the will of God either to the right or to the left, to add or to take away. He just did what he was told to do carefully and diligently. He took the commandment to heart and responded properly to the grace of God by faith (Heb.11:6,7). **SELECTED**
